Eligibility requirements

- Applicant must be a Consumers Energy residential electric customer.
- Pump must be an ENERGY STAR certified variable-speed pool pump, replacing a pool pump on an existing pool. Newly installed pools are not eligible for rebate.
- Limit one pool pump rebate per year, per household.
- Pool pump must be purchased and installed in 2020.
- Application must be postmarked within 30 days of installation.
- Rebate paid will not exceed the purchase price of the pool pump, excluding taxes, shipping and installation charges.
- Rebate eligibility requirements are subject to change without notice, including early termination of this program.

Please be sure to include a legible copy of your entire sales receipt with your application submission. The receipt or paid invoice must include the sales date, manufacturer, model number, installation date, purchase price and vendor name. Please retain a copy of the receipt and application for your records.
